

## **APPOINTMENT OF EXTERNAL AUDIT COMMITTEE MEMBERS (4)**

Applications or nominations are invited from suitably qualified and experienced candidates for appointment as external members of the Audit Committee of the Wholesale and Retail SETA.

The Audit Committee is a statutory committee of the Board of Directors comprised of four external members and two Board members from the Business and Labour constituencies. The Committee regulates and discharges all its responsibilities as outlined in the PFMA and the Audit Charter setting out the appropriate formal terms of reference. The Committee meets at least four times a year.

Applicants should preferably be qualified Chartered Accountants or in possession of an equivalent qualification. In addition the following skills, experience and attributes are required:

- Integrity, independence and dedication,
- Understanding of public entities,
- knowledge of internal and external audit functions in the public sector, the Public Finance Management Act and Treasury Regulations and their implications for public entities, management principles and ethics, and corporate governance principles,
- Served / currently serving on a Board or Board Committee of a public / private entity.

The successful applicant will be remunerated for attendance of meetings and related travel costs according to a rate that is based on the guidelines published by the Office of the Auditor-General for audits done on behalf of that Office.

Applications must be accompanied by a recent comprehensive *curriculum vitae* as well as a copy of identity document.
