Invites applications for the prestigious

International Leadership Development Programme (ILDLP) 2016-17

The W&RSETA is pleased to announce that the applications for the **2016/17** International Leadership Development Programme are officially open. The 2016 ILDP will commence from February 2016 to January 2017. The programme is open to potential Senior Managers who have been earmarked for Executive Management in their organisations in the Wholesale and Retail Sector. The programme will mainly focus on the accelerated development of senior managers who are drawn from Historically Disadvantaged Groups in line with the Employment Equity Act.

This intensive programme will be delivered by an accredited Higher Education and Training Institution appointed by the W&RSETA and will run over a 12-month period commencing in **February 2016** and includes a two -week international study tour and a week in an African country (depending on circumstances in Africa)

Participants will attend study blocks at the appointed Institutions, as well as a five-day programme during the international tours. One group of 25 delegates will study & tour the USA and Russia, whilst the other group does the China - India leg for their Immersion.

Only companies registered with the W&RSETA are eligible to nominate candidates for the Programme.
Special attention should be paid to the selection criteria when making nominations.

Large companies are eligible to nominate up to 5 candidates, medium companies up to 3 candidates and small companies can nominate 2 candidates. Companies are **NOT** allowed to nominate more than the prescribed number of candidates.
