

NON-PIVOTAL DISCRETIONARY GRANT FUNDING APPLICATION 2022/23

The Wholesale and Retail Sector Education and Training Authority (W&RSETA) invites suitably qualified and experienced providers with the ability to develop, implement, support, and administer an online Career Guidance Toolkit for the W&RSETA.

The purpose of the Online Career Guidance Toolkit is to capacitate and guide learners on various career options and opportunities in the Wholesale and Retail Sector. The toolkit should provide self-exploration tools and information relating to occupations, scarce skills and learning programmes across the W&R Sector.

Additionally, the following should be included in the Online Career Guidance Toolkit:

- Dynamic and interactive content for planned events such as career exhibitions, open windows for bursaries, learnerships, internships, graduate placement opportunities inclusive of persons with disabilities.
- Address an immediate need of the W&RSETA to ensure the correct allocation of funding for opportunities such
 as bursary application awards and access to learning programmes, as well as mentorship for small business
 development and opportunities for employment.

CRITERIA AND SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Proof of experience in similar or related scope and price
- 2. Three (3) reference letters on the letterhead of the referee company, indicating similar or related projects. The letter must include contact details of the referee, the date and year when similar or related project conducted on behalf of the referee.
- 3. CV and certified copies of qualifications of the lead project manager demonstrating relevant experience in the similar/related project.
- 4. Approach and methodology must be thoroughly demonstrated.
- 5. Implementation plan of the project must be clear and succinct.
