

## SUBMISSION OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR TVET PARTICPATION IN THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ASSESSMENT CENTRES

The W&RSETA has been appointed as one of the Assessment Quality Partners of the QCTO, and one of its functions is to recommend to the QCTO institutions that can be accredited as assessment centres.

To this end, the W&RSETA hereby invites public TVET colleges to submit expressions of interest to be established as an assessment centre for one of the following occupational qualifications:

- Occupational Qualification: Sales Assistant Retail Sales SAQA ID 99669
- Occupational Qualification: Service Station Attendant SAQA ID 99708
- Occupational Qualification: Store Person SAQA ID 99703
- Occupational Qualification: Bicycle Mechanic SAQA 99694

In establishing an assessment centre, the following criteria has to be met:

- Controlled and conducive summative assessment environment that promotes the completion of the knowledge component of the EISA.
- Practicum room that is relevant to the completion of the specific occupational qualification to allow learners to practically demonstrate their competence.
- Meet the compliance requirements in order to be recommended to the QCTO for accreditation as an assessment centre.

The W&RSETA will provide capacitation to TVET colleges on the Assessment Quality Partner criteria and guidelines for the establishment of assessment centres.

## **SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:**

The closing date for the submission of the expression of interest is Friday, **30 July 2021**. Expression of interest are to be emailed to <u>mmunsaur@wrseta.org.za</u> with the subject indicating "TVET Expression of Interest 2021". Any expression of interest not meeting the eligibility and criteria will be rendered null and void by the W&RSETA and expression of interest received after the closing date and time will not be considered. Allocations are subject to the sole discretion of the W&RSETA.
