TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Stakeholders that are eligible to apply for this grant include W&RSETA Accredited Training Providers, Providers with W&RSETA Scope and TVET Colleges
- Applications must be made by completing the Non-PIVOTAL DG20/21 Funding Window Application Form.
- Applications must be submitted to the nearest W&RSETA provincial office by 22 January 2021. No later applications will be considered.
- All learners must be registered on the SETA Management system by no later than 28 February 2021, therefore Learners Agreements, signed by all parties, must be submitted to the Provincial Office by no later than 19 February 202. Failure to register learners within the stipulated timelines will result in the withdrawal of the allocation and funding re-allocated to companies that are able to meet the timelines.
- Training must have commenced by 15 March 2021 for all three interventions.
- Stakeholder track record on successful implementation of W&RSETA-funded learning programmes will be considered when awarding funding allocations.
