<b>Registered Co-operatives Project</b>  <b>REF: Co-ops20/21</b>	20 Registered Co-operatives	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Learners can be recruited from any part of the country</li> <li>At least one member per Co-operative should be trained on a maximum of four Unit Standards which fall under Wholesale and Retail subfield and as enlisted in any W&amp;RSETA approved programme at R1 500.00 per Unit Standard</li> <li>Co-operatives can either be Primary or Secondary Co-operatives</li> <li>Participating Co-operatives must have registration documents</li> <li>Learners will receive 2 months stipends of R3000.00</li> <li>Each Co-operative will receive a once-off R500.00 PPE Support Grant</li> <li>Project duration is 6 months</li> </ul>

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Stakeholders that are eligible to apply for this grant include W&RSETA Accredited Training Providers, Providers with W&RSETA Scope and TVET Colleges
- Applications must be made by completing the **Non-PIVOTAL DG20/21 Funding Window Application Form**.
- Applications must be submitted to the nearest W&RSETA provincial office by **22 January 2021**. No later applications will be considered.
- All learners must be registered on the SETA Management system by no later than **28 February 2021**, therefore Learners Agreements, signed by all parties, must be submitted to the Provincial Office by no later than **19 February 2021**. Failure to register learners within the stipulated timelines will result in the withdrawal of the allocation and funding re-allocated to companies that are able to meet the timelines.
- Training must have commenced by **15 March 2021** for all three interventions.
- Stakeholder track record on successful implementation of W&RSETA-funded learning programmes will be considered when awarding funding allocations.
