Submit monthly progress and closure reports

- The successful institution must be able to conduct Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) for candidates with NQF level 5 qualification plus 10 years' Supervisor / Management experience in the sector to enable them to enter into the programme where applicable.
- The training provider must have a valid SAQA accreditation/registration and registered with the Department of Higher Education and Training.
- The training provider must be in good standing with SARS.
- Applications must be made by completing the PIVOTAL DG22/23 Funding Window Application
 Form.
- Applicants must submit a detailed implementation plan including the credentials and experience of the faculty that will be appointed for this programme.
- All delegates must be registered on the W&RSETA Learner Benefit Template by no later than 15 February 2023. Learner agreements signed by all parties, must be submitted to the W&RSETA by 28 February 2023. A hard drive or memory stick with electronic files must be submitted to the SETA together with a physical file with details of all learners.
- All delegates must be registered with the institution by 15 February 2023.
- Track record with client references on successful implementation of management development programmes must be demonstrated.
- Experience in delivering management development programme in the Wholesale and Retail Sector will be an added advantage.
- Failure to meet deliverables stipulated within the provided timeliness will result in the withdrawal of the allocation and funding re-allocated to an institution that is able to meet the timelines.
