

APPLICATIONS FOR THE RETAIL MANAGEMENT DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (RMDP) 2023/24 ARE OPEN

The W&RSETA invites wholesale and retail companies to apply for the Retail Management Development Programme (RMDP) 2023/24. The RMDP focuses on the development of middle managers, supervisors and team leaders drawn from historically disadvantaged groups in line with the Employment Equity Act (companies are encouraged to prioritise Africans particularly women and people with disabilities). The programme is aimed at addressing skills gaps within the middle management component of the Wholesale and Retail Sector by equipping middle managers, supervisors, and team leaders with relevant skills to become effective managers.

The RMDP will be implemented on NQF levels 5 to 7 qualifications and will be delivered through a hybrid mode (online and physical block classes). The W&RSETA has appointed the following institutions to deliver the RMDP. Candidates must select only one institution.

*Companies are NOT allowed to nominate more than the prescribed number of candidates.

- <u>W&RSETA Nomination Form</u> (indicate a valid Skills Development Levy Number)
- Confirmation of employment letter
- Certified ID copy (not older than 6 months)
- Certified copy of highest qualification (not older than 6 months)
- Curriculum Vitae

Applications must be submitted through the links provided for the different institutions indicated above by **10 November 2023**. No late applications will be considered.
