

DISCRETIONARY GRANT 2024/25 AND 2025/26 FUNDING WINDOW FOR **SPECIAL PROJECTS**

The Wholesale and Retail Sector Education and Training Authority (W&RSETA) invites applications for partnership proposals and/or special project proposals for 2024/25 and 2025/26 financial year periods. Project proposals must address any of the key priority skills areas as identified in the W&RSETA Sector Skills Plan.

The qualifying proposals for strategic partnerships will be included on the panel to be considered for implementation in line with the W&RSETA priorities.

APPLICATION CRITERIA

- Applicant must be operating in the Wholesale and Retail Sector with the exception of CET colleges, TVET colleges, HET institutions and other government entities.
- A fully completed prescribed application proposal template must be submitted with the proposal.
- The proposal must clearly demonstrate the skills priorities that the proposal aims to address and the contribution of the applicant.
- Tax compliance through a tax clearance certificate/PIN or a tax exemption letter where applicable.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

The Application Proposal template and supporting documentation indicated above, must be submitted to SpecialProjects@wrseta.org.za by 15 September 2024. No late applications will be considered.

- Application must address one or more of the key priority interventions as listed above.
- Proposals/partnerships with a shared budget or co-funding options will be given preferential consideration.

- Proposals not responded to by 28 February 2025 should be considered unsuccessful.
